MALA Update

We sent you a survey on the MALA statewide courier service at the first of the month. This survey is administered annually as part of the LSTA grant, and is required by the State Library. We have streamlined the survey to keep it short and meaningful.

We still have not received responses from the majority of libraries on the courier service. Please help us by responding to the survey. We want the library director or a knowledgeable member of staff who handles the interlibrary loan function to complete and submit the survey before the deadline of October 15.

Completing this survey is essential to the LSTA grant process. The grant allows you to have free interlibrary loan courier service, thanks to the Missouri State Library. We need participation in this survey to maintain grant eligibility. Please. Take a few moments to complete the survey to ensure the continuation of your free statewide courier service. Thank you.

Speaking of statistics...

The monthly courier statistics, which we ask you to self-report in a simple website form each month, are likewise crucial to the continuation of the statewide courier service. The numbers you provide justify the service's existence. If you don't report your courier numbers, we can't get a sense of how much actual use there is, or how best to adjust our service model to optimize delivery routes. Please, please submit your monthly statistics by the 5th of the month. We count on you!

We have received positive feedback, and a few corrections, on our new <u>ILL CONTACT LIST</u> for member libraries on our website. The list contains names, email addresses, phone numbers, cities, and hubs for the participating MALA courier libraries. The list is password protected. The password is MALAILL [all caps]. Please use it to communicate with your ILL partners!

New Courier Bags Are Here!

Our supply of courier bags has been augmented with a new batch of the 8x12 blue woven pouches made for us by Z Manufacturing, Inc. in Piedmont, MO. Thanks for Sue Szostak and her staff at Poplar Bluff Municipal

Library for letting MALA use her library as a drop off and pick up point. Great teamwork!

These smaller-sized bags ensure that materials don't shift around as much, and protect contents better than the thinner nylon bags. Don't overstuff this or any other courier bag. Bulging bags risk damage to contents, and often push the paper label right out of the display window, delaying delivery as the item needs to be opened and re-labeled. Continue to enclose DVDs in small cardboard boxes whenever possible (you can recycle used boxes indefinitely for this purpose), and stack books into bags either spine side down, or side by side, spines out. The judicious use of protective inserts such as bubble wrap or cardboard is encouraged.
