MALA Updates

MALA Courier Holiday - Labor Day

MALA will be closed on Monday, September 4 in observance of Labor Day; you will not receive deliveries on that day. Delivery resumes on Tuesday.

Upcoming Holidays - have you reported?

Are you closed on Columbus or Veteran's Day? Have you reported all of your upcoming holidays on the Schedule Holiday & Closings sheet so MALA can notify your courier? Please do that here if you have not.

Water Damaged Items

In recent months, some libraries have reported items being delivered wet or with water damage. MALA is tracking this issue and working with Henry to get this resolved. To help MALA track the problem, please report any deliveries with wet items or standing water in the totes, regardless of if items are damaged. This should be reported on MALA's "Report Courier Delivery Service Issues" form. While reimbursement cannot be guaranteed, any items that need to be discarded because of water damage may be considered for reimbursement. To be considered for reimbursement, these items should also be reported on MALA's "Report Lost, Damaged, or Found Items" form and photos depicting the damage should be sent to the Courier Coordinator (katrina.high@malalibraries.org). While typically photographs are all MALA needs to make a determination, in some instances physical materials may need to be inspected by MALA either to determine eligibility for reimbursement or to help MALA identify potential resolutions to this issue.

Reporting Courier Issues

Please report <u>any</u> courier delivery service issue to MALA's <u>"Report Courier Delivery Service Issues"</u> form rather than emailing or calling MALA staff. This form helps MALA keep track of delivery issues. Additionally, the responses to this form are able to be accessed by multiple people in MALA's offices. This ensures that MALA staff will be able to respond to your issue in a timely manner.
